Ministries courses may qualify for advanced placement in graduate school. Successful completion (grade "B" or better) of several of the courses offered through the ministries degree program may qualify you to receive advanced course placement in the Master of Arts in Theological Studies or Master of Divinity programs offered through the Center for Graduate Studies.

If you plan to pursue graduate study in theology, you will want to work with your academic advisor to select courses that could qualify for advanced placement. Ask your admission counselor for details.
