

If you are just beginning your college journey, the **Associate of Arts in General Studies** offers foundational coursework in communication, history, art, literature, mathematics, science and Bible. Each subject is taught in the context of a Christian worldview and faith and learning are integrated into every subject.

For those who have never attended college, you can anticipate earning your associate's degree in approximately 32 months by attending class just once a week (6–10 p.m.) on Northwestern's campus. Students with previous college or technical training often transfer in prior credits and may complete the program sooner.
