University of Northwestern – St. Paul seeks public comment about university

ST. PAUL, Minn., August 30, 2018—University of Northwestern is seeking comments from the public about the University in preparation for its periodic evaluation by its regional accrediting agency. The University will host a visit November 12-13, 2018 with a team representing the Higher Learning Commission. Initial accreditation for University of Northwestern – St. Paul was in April 1978; with reaffirmation of accreditation granted in June 1989, June 1999, and October 2009. The team will review the institution’s ongoing ability to meet HLC’s Criteria for Accreditation.
