School of Nursing Financial Aid Fact Sheet

Traditional undergraduates (continuing students):

Cohorts starts summer or fall. Summer start has the same tuition as the previous fall and spring semesters. Official awards are made upon acceptance to the program as long as financial aid application is complete, including the FAFSA for the appropriate school year and any other required documentation. See with financial aid with any questions.

Transfer undergraduates:

Same as above. Be sure to add Northwestern’s school code (002371) to an existing FAFSA and inform Financial Aid of loans received that same academic year at previous institutions.

Post-Baccalaureate students:

Tuition is charged per credit for all levels of enrollment. Post-bacc students receive reduced tuition in lieu of gift aid. Refer to transfer instructions above if applicable.
