



Military Tuition Discount Application, Terms & Conditions

1. This discount is only available to admitted students seeking a degree program and/or certificate that are in the US Armed Forces (including Reserves and National Guard) as well as veterans or personnel currently serving full or part-time in any branch of the US Armed Forces.
2. This discount is for the admitted student only, no family members.
3. This discount may not be used concurrently with any other official Northwestern tuition discount programs and/or scholarships. In the event a student receives full tuition to cover the tuition from federal and/or state funding, Northwestern reserves the right to reduce any discounts or incentives given by the university.
4. This discount is for courses taken in Adult & Graduate Studies degree seeking programs or certificates
5. For Minnesota Residents Only: Students must apply for and submit the appropriate FAFSA application.
6. Students who have been discharged from the military must submit an official DD214 transcript. Students who are on active military duty should submit a copy of their current military orders or a letter verifying active status from their commanding officer. If the student is an active Reserves or National Guard member, they should submit a copy of their current contract.
7. MN students must apply and annually submit the MN GI Bill application to remain eligible for this discount.
8. This discount will be up to \$750 per semester for full-time (12+ credits) adult undergraduate students and up to \$440 per semester for full-time (6+ credits) graduate students, less other funds received.
9. Discount will be applied approximately 30 days into each semester.
